

29 - The Final Word (Revelation 22:6-21)

I. The Certainty of the Return of Christ (Revelation 22:6-7)

A. The Surety of the Prophecy (Revelation 22:6a)

- The angel proclaims that all that John has seen is true.

B. The Purpose of the Prophecy (Revelation 22:6b)

- The prophecy was given to show that which will take place shortly.

C. The Promise (Revelation 22:7)

- Christ promises to return quickly.
- A blessing is bestowed on those who hold to the prophecy.

II. The Worship by John (Revelation 22:8-9)

A. John Worships the One Standing By (Revelation 22:8)

- John responds to the words by worshipping the one standing by.

B. The Rebuke of the One Standing By (Revelation 22:9)

- The one standing by rebukes John and tells him to worship God only.

III. The Command to Proclaim the Prophecy of the Book (Revelation 22:10-11)

A. The Prophecy is not to be Sealed (Revelation 22:10)

- This prophecy is not to be hidden.

B. The Response to the Prophecy (Revelation 22:11)

- Those who do not heed the prophecy will continue in their wickedness.
- Those who heed the prophecy will continue to do right.

IV. The Coming Judgment and Reward (Revelation 22:12)

- Christ is returning to give everyone their just reward.

V. The Eternal Christ (Revelation 22:13)

- Christ proclaims Himself as Eternal God.

VI. The Coming Blessing and Judgment (Revelation 22:14-15)

A. The Blessing (Revelation 22:14)

- Those who persevere will inherit eternal life.

B. The Judgment (Revelation 22:15)

- The wicked will have no part in eternal life.

VII. The Invitation of the Spirit and the Bride (Revelation 22:16-17)

A. Jesus Identifies Himself (Revelation 22:16)

- Jesus identifies Himself as to one who sent His angels to proclaim the prophecy.

B. The Call to Salvation (Revelation 22:17)

- The call is given to those who are searching to come.

VIII. The Final Warning (Revelation 22:18-19)

- The one who reject the book by altering it will be judged severely.

IX. The Prayer and Promise (Revelation 22:20-21)

- Jesus promises to come quickly.
